

The Redwood Marching Band & Color Guard Chaperone Information

Chaperones are extremely important for the success of our Band and Color Guard! We really appreciate the fact that you are giving up your day to be sure our students are safe and well cared for before, during, and after each parade. Without your help we could not travel! You will all be assigned various jobs the day of the event you are volunteering for.

Chaperones need to carry the following items in a day-pack/backpack:

- 2 4 sport/squirt bottles (examples below) with cold water
- small tube of sunscreen
- small bottle of hand sanitizer
- water and snack for yourself during the parade and bus rides
- bag of nut-free snacks to share with students (for about 10 students) on bus ride (pretzels and other non-messy snacks are best)

Chaperones should be dressed in <u>dark</u> long pants or jeans, and a <u>white</u> long or shortsleeved shirt, and a black jacket. If you do not have a black jacket, we can loan you a black chaperone jacket on the morning of the event.

We strongly recommend a hat or visor, as it can get quite hot during some events.

Please try to avoid wearing colored jackets and sweaters. We would like our chaperones to have somewhat of a uniform look as well, as this helps our students better identify you when need be.
