A-Period Bands

Monday - Friday, A-Period (7:25-8:10 AM)

Location: Redwood Middle School music room (51)

For the intermediate instrumentalist with primary instruction on a woodwind, brass, or percussion instrument. This period of band occurs during Redwood's A Period from 7:25 – 8:10 AM before the normal school day begins. The focus of this class period is to continue growth and progress of what students have learned previously in their previous groups including theory, technique, and aspects of performance.

Strong 6th grade musicians who are interested in taking band as their in-school elective in place of the exploratory wheel may also audition for placement into more advanced ensembles. Please refer to more information on the Symphonic & Concert Bands handout.
