MUSICIANS

- 1. REDWOOD BAND UNIFORM. Wear athletic shorts and a black T-shirt underneath.
 - Wear regular day shoes with <u>ALL-BLACK, CREW-LENGTH SOCKS</u>.
- 2. **BLACK MARCHING SHOES** will be distributed upon student arrival to Redwood. Don't forget to wear your all-black, crew-length socks to school!
- 3. **REDWOOD BAND SHAKOS (HATS)** will be also distributed on the morning of the parade.

COLOR GUARD

- 1. COLOR GUARD BLACK PANTS
- 2. COLOR GUARD SHOES
- 3. **Optional: SOCKS** (must be nude or black sock LINERS like those you wear with ballet flats, absolutely unseen when worn)
- 4. **HAIR** slicked back with gel in a high-braided ponytail (no fly-aways!!!). *If you cannot get this done at home, arrive 15 minutes earlier in the morning with your hairbrush, gel, clean & combed out hair).*
- 5. "UGLY"/HOLIDAY SWEATER of your choice and approved by Cece

Please be sure to have all items prepared and ready when you arrive. We do several final preparations as a group in the morning, so when students arrive late or improperly prepared, it delays us significantly as we have to fix individuals and go over everything once again. Students should have the following things in hand when they arrive:

- A healthy (nut-free) snack and water for <u>after our performance</u> (have a hearty breakfast at home so that it may hold you over until after we perform!). Please be sure that your snacks are "clean"...meaning nothing that could stain or stick to your uniforms (no Doritos/Cheetos, jelly/jam, etc.)

Another reminder: Please <u>do not bring</u> garment bags And another reminder: Please <u>do not bring</u> changes of clothes, or daypacks as we will be coming straight home after completing the parade
