On Saturday, students should arrive by 8:00 AM (or 7:30 AM if taking individual/buddy pictures) and will hopefully be done by 2:00 PM. Since this is a free-moving parade, ending times are approximate.

Parents/guardians: Be sure that both you and your student reviews all information, and please make sure that your student has a ride once we return. No student should be waiting at school to be picked up longer than 15 minutes after they are excused.

If you will need to get your hair done at school, please be sure to bring your own hair brush, hair gel and hair ties.

MUSICIANS

- 1. REDWOOD BAND UNIFORM. Wear athletic shorts and a Black T-shirt underneath.
- 2. **BLACK MARCHING SHOES AND ALL-BLACK SOCKS**. These shoes need to be used only for band performances, otherwise it will be impossible to keep them looking sharp and clean. <u>PLEASE BE SURE TO HAVE ALL-BLACK CREW-LENGTH SOCKS</u>.
- 3. **REDWOOD BAND SHAKOS (HATS)** will be distributed on the morning of the parade.
- 4. All students with long **hair** must have their hair "glued" to their heads so that it will fit into the top of their shako!

COLOR GUARD

- 1. COLOR GUARD DRESS (girls) / SHIRT (guys) and BLACK PANTS (all)
- 2. COLOR GUARD SHOES
- 3. **Optional: SOCKS** (must be nude or black sock LINERS like those you wear with ballet flats, absolutely unseen when worn)
- 4. **HAIR** slicked back with gel in a high-braided ponytail (no fly-aways!!!). *If you cannot get this done at home, arrive 15 minutes earlier in the morning with your hairbrush, gel, clean & combed out hair*).
- 5. IN YOUR GARMENT BAG (to change into following our pictures: "UGLY"/HOLIDAY SWEATER of your choice and approved by Mr. Jazz

Please be sure to have all items prepared and ready when you arrive. We do several final preparations as a group in the morning, so when students arrive late or improperly prepared, it delays us significantly as we have to fix individuals and go over everything once again. Students should have the following things in hand when they arrive:

- A healthy (nut-free) snack and water for <u>after our performance</u> (have a hearty breakfast at home so that it may hold you over until after we perform!)
 - o Please be sure that your snacks are "clean"...meaning nothing that could stain or stick to your uniforms (no Doritos/Cheetos, jelly/jam, etc.)

Musicians: Please <u>do not bring</u> garment bags Guard: Bring your garment bag with your sweater All: Please <u>do not bring</u> changes of clothes, or daypacks as we will be coming straight home after completing the parade

9:30 AM Arrive, check in, unload & warm up

c. 1:15 PM Depart for return to Redwood

c. 1:45 PM Arrive at Redwood; everyone must help unload the truck

c. 2:00 PM Students dismissed -- Parents, please be on call to pick up your students on time!
