



Picture Time!

Schedules for Redwood's participation in the San Jose Veterans' Day Parade will be coming out soon. In addition to the parade, we take a full group pictures in the morning before we leave from Redwood.

Students will receive a picture order envelope with this flyer. No standard picture is included in the marching band registration. Any pictures that students would like should be ordered via the envelope.

Be sure to fill out your information on the left hand side of the envelope including the following information:

League: - (none)

Team/Sport: Marching Band & Color guard

School: Redwood Middle

(no need to complete the check boxes for Varsity, JV, etc.)

You may order picture packages, individual pictures or item sets in the middle column, or packages. A description of the first four packages may be found on the right of the envelope.

We will take a full group picture (including color guard) as well as a color guard picture. **If you would like to order the color guard picture *instead of the full group*, please clearly write in "CG" next to the picture order, to the left of the "Quantity" column.** You may always order more than one picture if you would like a full group picture as well as a color guard picture. Simply be sure that this is clear on your envelope. If you have any questions, students should bring their envelopes and see Mr. Jow for clarification.

If you are ordering package A, B, C, or D, be sure to circle/indicate whether you will be taking an individual ("I") picture or a buddy picture with friends ("B").

If you are ordering individual items, be sure to circle/indicate whether you are ordering a team picture ("T"), or an individual ("I") or buddy ("B") picture.

Total your order amount, provide your credit card number on the envelope, **or** write a check to "Wayne Salvatore" and insert it into the envelope. Cash may also be used for payment. Turn in to the music room by Monday, November 5.

If you are taking individual or group pictures, you and your buddies will arrive at Redwood slightly earlier than others to take these pictures, at about 8:00 AM. Stay tuned for exact times!
